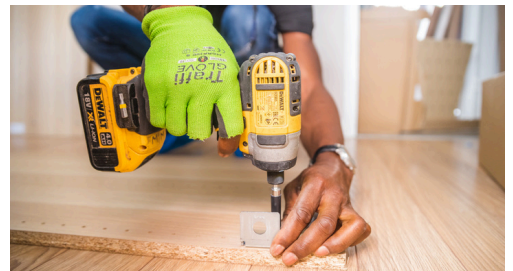

If the card or certificate does not bare an expiration date, then the card or certificate is valid for two (2) years from date of issuance under 25 TAC §229.178 relating to Accreditation of Food Handler Education or Training Programs.

#### ASL Classes:

- *For children 6 months to 4 years old: Every Monday for 6 weeks, four times a year. Cost is \$40 for parents and child, and \$50 for families with 2 or more children.*
- *For children 6 to 17 years old: Three summer camps available, prices and times vary depending on enrollment. Please check the [DHHC Facebook page](#) for price, time, and adventures.*
- *For adults: ASL 1 class is offered four times a year and is held every Monday for 6 weeks; cost is \$60 per person. Discounts available for families and seniors. Remote courses available.*

*Silent Senior Citizens Program: Seniors meet every Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to play games, have lunch, and have fun.*

*Technology Specialist will help people with a hearing disadvantage learn what type of hearing assisted technology, devices, resources, and accommodations are available to help them. Ask for Thomas.*

*Interpretive services bridge the communication gaps between the d/Deaf and the Hearing community. Ask for Jim.*
