# **Discovery Dome Limitations and Requirements:**

Limitations:

- Available to schools and educational organizations within Corpus Christi.
- Maximum capacity is around 20 people or 1 class per showing.
- Limits on time and day availability may apply depending on Corpus Christi Public Library (CCPL) staff availability.

Personnel Requirements:

- CCPL staff required to be present to move and operate the dome.
- Staff member or adult volunteer provided by the host organization to help library personnel load and unload the Dome equipment from the transit van.
- Staff member or adult volunteer provided by the host organization to assist with running the Dome during shows.

Space Requirements:

- Indoor use only.
- Space required is 20ft X 20ft with a 10ft ceiling.
- Accessible power outlet near the dome.
- Ramp access to storage and show area.
- The Discovery Dome and supplies may be delivered and picked up days before/after the showing. All equipment must be stored in a secure location after delivery and before pick-up.

Time Requirements:

- One hour for set up and one hour for breakdown.
- Intermission (10 minutes) between shows.
- Must be reserved no fewer than three weeks before event.
- For Discovery Dome requests that last over 6 hours, including setup time, a 1-hour lunch break may be required for CCPL staff.

Your time will not be reserved until we receive the request form (page 1), so please submit it as early as possible. Someone from the Ben F. McDonald Public Library will contact you once we receive the request form and your event will be added to our calendar. You will be contacted again once CCPL staff availability has been confirmed. Arrangements form (page 2) required no fewer than two weeks before the event.
