

ACCESS MAINTENANCE INFORMATION

ChiltonLibrary

Gale's ChiltonLibrary provides you with up to date repair, maintenance, and labor estimating for most automotive makes, years, and models. Utilize this tip sheet to access the **Maintenance** section of the resource to get a clear view of what maintenance your vehicle needs and when.

ENTER YOUR VEHICLE INFORMATION

After you log in to *ChiltonLibrary*, you will be prompted to enter the year, make, and model of your vehicle.

You will not be able to see maintenance information until you enter your vehicle.

NAVIGATE TO THE MAINTENANCE SECTION

Utilize the gray toolbar towards the top of the page to select the **Maintenance** section.

Once in the **Maintenance** section, you can either enter your vehicle configuration, or view a full maintenance chart.

ENTER VEHICLE CONFIGURATION

Utilize the drop down menus to specify your exact configuration.

Once each drop down is completed a maintenance schedule will appear for **Maintenance 1 and 2** (the initial maintenance your vehicle needs).

If you select **Additional Normal** or **Additional Severe** under **Operating Condition** you will see suggested maintenance by mileage.

VIEW FULL CHART LIST

If you do not want to enter- or do not know- your vehicle's configuration, select the **Full Chart List** option.

From here you will see all configurations listed with the option to view their maintenance schedules.
