LIFEGUARD ACADEMY

Before the Summer Peak Season starts, the City of Corpus Christi Beach Rescue trains a group of lifeguard candidates, or “rookies,” during the Lifeguard Academy. The academy uses the curriculum of the United States Lifesaving Association. Lifesaving skills are learned in the classroom environment and the open water of the Gulf of America.

The course consists of 40 hours of training, including the American Safety and Health Institute's (ASHI) Emergency Medical Responder course, the United States Lifesaving Association's Open Water Lifeguard Training, public interaction training, and physical training.

Lifeguard candidates will be paid for training and are expected to bring their own swimsuits. Lifeguard Academy uniforms will be issued during the training. Upon successful completion of the Lifeguard Academy, candidates will be issued their Lifeguard uniform and be eligible to work for the City of Corpus Christi Beach Rescue.
