Collection Guidelines

- Carts are assigned to your street address.
- Do not take carts when relocating to a new residence.
- Do not use carts to haul trash off the premises.
- Report damaged and stolen carts to the City's Call Center by dialing 3-1-1.

Need an Extra Trash or Recycling Cart?








- An additional trash cart costs \$10.50 a month.
- There is a one-time delivery fee of \$11.55.
- An additional recycling cart can be provided at no cost.
- Contact the City's Call Center by dialing 3-1-1 to schedule delivery.

Items that do NOT belong in the carts:

- Ammunition
- Hot Ashes
- Hazardous Materials
- Large Appliances
- Illegal Substances
- Tires
- Concrete
- · Construction Materials
- · Soil or Dirt
- Paint

Setting Out and Storing Carts

- All trash must be bagged and tied to prevent spillage, but do not bag your recyclables.
- Place your cart(s) at the curb, not blocking the street, no later than 7:30 a.m. on your collection day.
- Leave at least 5 feet of clearance from other carts, vehicles, and mailboxes.



- Place your cart away from low-hanging branches, shrubbery, or other obstacles.
- Make sure the lid on your cart closes completely.
- · Do not overfill your cart.
- Do not place items on top or beside your cart.
- Please move your vehicle off the street to make way for the garbage and recycling trucks.
- Remove your empty cart from the curb the same day it is collected.
- Carts left curbside after the scheduled pick-up are subject to fines.

Need Help with Your Carts?

If you are physically or medically unable to place your cart at the curb, contact the City's Call Center by dialing **3-1-1**.



Recycling & Trash

Collection

- Trash is collected once weekly on the same day, as determined by your address.
- Recycling is collected once every two weeks on the same day as your trash.
- Collection calendars are available on the City website.

J.C. Elliott Transfer Station

Residential customers can use the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station for additional debris and trash disposal. There is **no fee for residential customers** paying for City collection services when bringing waste produced at their residence. A valid **U.S. government-issued ID** is required for entry.



Electronic Recycling

Only residential electronics are **accepted** at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station:

- Computers
- Printers
- Keyboards
- Mobile Devices
- Rechargeable Batteries
- Other Electronics



Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Items accepted at no charge to Corpus Christi residents:

- Antifreeze
- Solvents
- Brake Fluid
- Transmission Fluid
- Batteries
- Cleaning Solvents
- Oven Cleaner
- Pool Chemicals
- Paint

- Paint Thinner
- Paint Stripper
- Spray Paint
- Weed Killer
- Poisons
- Polishes
- Pesticides
- Insecticides

Items must be properly labeled and in a container no larger than 5 gallons. Prescription medication must be placed in the trash.

Disposal for Contractors & Commercial Operators

Hauler Permit

\$50 PER YEAR Valid August 31, 2024, through September 1, 2025

A Hauler Permit is required for any person, business, commercial establishment, or industrial facility, other than a residential customer that collects, transports, or disposes of solid waste generated by the person, business, commercial establishment, or industrial facility.

- Hauler permit must be displayed on their vehicle.
- Haulers will be charged according to established rates.

The Super Bag Collection Service is for customers who want convenient, scheduled pickup of leftover material from small home renovations, trash cleanups, landscaping, and other household projects.

- A Super Bag costs \$135, including tax.
- Super Bags are available at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station for use within City limits.
- No limit to the number of Super Bags customers can purchase at one time.
- Super Bags measure L 96" x W 48" x H 30".
- Super Bags can hold up to 2,200 lbs.
- Place and load the Super Bag within 15 feet of the curb for accessible collection.
- Sidewalks and streets must be kept free from obstructions.
- Contact the City's Call Center by dialing
 3-1-1 to schedule collection.
- · Collected within three business days.

Residents could be fined for improper set-out.

Recycle RIGHT Program

Recycle RIGHT is a city-wide program geared towards improving the recycling habits of residential customers through education and outreach. The goal is to reduce the amount of trash placed in recycling carts.

- Improves the quality of recyclable items.
- Increases the value of recyclable material.
- Reduces processing costs.
- Helps ensure a sustainable recycling program.

Recycle RIGHT Tips

- Do NOT bag your recyclables; place them loose inside your blue cart.
- Plastic bags of any kind are NOT recyclable.
- Products made with two or more materials are NOT recyclable.

Ex: Spiral notebooks or padded/bubble mailers

Only recycling symbols with the numbers 1,
2 & 5 are accepted in our program.

The Corpus Christi Police Department (CCPD) highly urges residents to report any graffiti in your area. Graffiti on buildings and fences not only diminishes property values for everyone in the community but also fosters a feeling of decline.

- To schedule a graffiti cleanup, contact the City's Call Center by dialing 3-1-1.
- To report an act of graffiti in progress, call 911.
- To report graffiti that has already occurred, call the CCPD non-emergency number at 361-886-2600.

Dead Animal Collection

Solid Waste Services is here to help residents with the collection of deceased animals. To request a pickup, please reach out to the City's Call Center by calling 311. If you can, please bag the dead animal and place it in the right-of-way in front of your home.

Community Cleanup Program

The Litter Critter is a **FREE** monthly community cleanup event that allows customers the opportunity to dispose of residential trash, brush, and household items.

Brush Collection Program

- Brush is collected from your residence two times each year.
- Only set out brush for collection during authorized set-out dates.
- Brush will be collected the week following the set-out dates for your area.
- The 2024-2025 brush and bulky collection schedules are available on pages 17 and 18 in this guide and the City website.

Brush Set-Out Guidelines

Brush set-out for collection includes:

- Shrubs
- Tree Limbs
- Grass Clippings
- Weeds
- Leaves
- Mulch
- Tree Trimmings
- · Lumber is not considered brush.
- Customers are limited to one truckload of materials during each scheduled brush collection.
- There is a fee for each additional truckload collected.
- Place small yard waste in your green/brown trash cart throughout the year.

Do **NOT** place brush on or near the following:

- Streets/Sidewalks
- Gutters
- Against Fences
- Drainage Ditches
- Cars
- Gas/Water Meters
- Mailboxes
- Vacant Lots

- Neighboring Properties
 - By Utility Poles
 - Beneath Wires
 - Under Low-Hanging Branches

*Improper set-out could result in a fee.

Bulky Collection Program

Collection Schedule

- Bulky items are collected twice per year.
- Place your items curbside for collection during authorized bulky items set-out dates only.
- The 2024-2025 bulky collection schedule is available on pages 17 and 18 in this guide.

- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Box Springs
- Carpet
- Metal or Plastic Swing Sets
- Plastic Swimming Pools
- Large Toys
- Bicycles
- Aquariums
- Large Household Appliances
- Up to 4 tires, 20 inches or less


Separate bulky items into individual piles by group:

- Chemicals

- Concrete
 - Remove freon from appliances.
